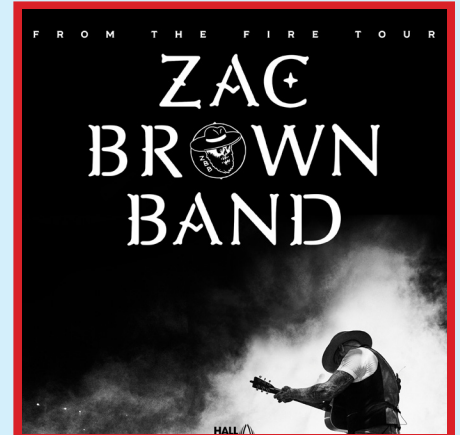

The Pro Football Hall of Fame adheres to NFL Best Practices, thus security procedures used during all NFL games will be used at Tom Benson Hall of Fame Stadium. As you arrive at the gate for your security check, you and your belongings will be screened for prohibited items. All individuals are subject to walking through a metal detector as part of the screening process.

Due to enhanced security procedures the only bags, packages or containers permitted to be carried by fans as they enter the stadium are the following:

- An officially licensed clear Hall of Fame or NFL logo bag measuring 12" x 6" x 12". These bags are available for purchase at ProFootballHOF.com/store.
- A one-gallon clear plastic freezer bag (Ziplock bag or similar).
- Clutch purses no larger than 4.5" x 6.5"
- Medically necessary items will be admitted after being screened at the appropriate gate.

PLEASE PLAN ON ALLOWING EXTRA TIME TO ENTER THE STADIUM. We thank you for your patience and understanding to ensure the safety of all guests. Prohibited items discovered during inspections will not be allowed in the Stadium. You may return prohibited items to your vehicle or dispose of them at the gate.

By presenting your ticket and entering the Stadium you consent to such searches and waive any related claims that you might have against the NFL, its member clubs, the Pro Football Hall of Fame, Hall of Fame Village LLC and related entities, or their agents. If you elect not to consent to the searches you will be denied entry into the Stadium.

ITEMS ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE

Please Note:

For the health, safety, and comfort of all guests, smoking and all other tobacco products to include: cigarettes, electronic cigarettes, smoking devices, vaping devices, dip tobacco, and all other tobacco-related products are prohibited inside all of areas of the stadium.

Per Ohio Revised Code 2923.122 firearms are strictly prohibited.

Violators are subject to ejection and prosecution.

Permitted

- Binoculars (without the case)
- Cameras (without the case) are permitted but the images cannot be commercially used. (Lens cannot extend over six inches)
- Wheelchairs, motorized medical scooters and valid medical devices
- Clutch purses no larger than 4.5" x 6.5"
- Clear plastic, vinyl or PVC bags smaller than 12" x 6" x 12"
- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bags

Prohibited

- Aerosol cans
- Alcoholic beverages
- Animals (except service animals for fans with disabilities)
- Bags that are not clear
- Balloons (air & helium)
- Beach balls
- Bottle caps
- Camera cases
- Camera lenses over 6 inches
- Cans, bottles, bottled

- or boxed liquids
- Commercial audio/video recording equipment and tripods
- Confetti or glitter
- Coolers of any kind, including small soft pack coolers
- Diaper Bags
- Drones
- Fireworks or missile-like objects
- Food or drink

- Frisbees
- Ice chests
- iPads
- Illegal substances
- Knives
- Laptops/tablets
- Large purses
- Laser lights & pointers
- Mace/pepper spray
- Noisemaking devices: (i.e., air horns, bells, bullhorns, thundersticks, whistles, etc.)

- Plastic bottles
- Seat Cushions
- Selfie sticks (all types)
- Signage (political, advertising, derogatory)
- Sticks, poles, bats or clubs
- Strollers
- Solicitation to include flyers, giveaways, or samplings
- Thermoses
- Tobacco products to include cigarettes

- T-shirts or clothing items with vulgar language or phrasing
- Umbrellas
- Unmanned and Remote Controlled Aircraft Systems (drones) are strictly prohibited.
- Weapons: No weapons are allowed in the Stadium. Possession of a firearm or weapon are strictly forbidden.
